Dr. Dimova was visiting researcher and/or lecturer in Russia, USA, Japan, UK, Ireland and Greece. She was a consultant for UNDP and ILO (1997-98), World Bank (2001-2002), UNIFEM (2000-2005), European Foundation for the Improvement Working and Living Conditions (2003-2004). In 2002-2003 she worked for the National Centre for Social Research in London (UK) as a European Commission's Marie Curie Fellow. In 2005 and in 2011 she was an independent expert Peer Reviewer for the European Commission on women's employment and on gender pay gap. She is fluent in Russian and English.
