The European Researchers' Night (NIGHT) is a Europe-wide public set of events to stimulate interest in research careers, especially among young people

- Last Friday of September. Possibility to organise pre-event(s) in spring and summer
- Strong interaction between researchers and general public
- Simultaneous occurrence of the events throughout Europe and mobilisation of various communities to present research results

NEW!

2018 CEUROPEAN YEAR OF CULTURAL HERITAGE #EuropeForCulture

- ✓ Topic freely chosen by the applicants
- ✓ Up to 2 full days main event
- ✓ 2018 European Year of Cultural Heritage, applicants are encouraged to include activities relating to cultural heritage
- √ 50% budget increase: from EUR 8 to 12 million

- ✓ European Researchers' Night= EU flagship initiative
- √ Happening 1 day (or maximum 2 so far)
- ✓ Possibility to organise pre-event(s) in spring or summer prior to, and in line with, the main event in September (not mandatory)





NEW!

- ✓ Rationale for pre-event(s)
 - ✓ To raise awareness even further about the researchers work and spread the European Researchers' Night initiative during the year through events happening at different timings at local/regional/national level
 - ✓ To attract people to the main event in September
 - ✓ Inform about EU funding opportunities

Communication issues:

- Train the fellows to reach out the general public Fellows find it particularly rewarding!
- Engage participants
- Read Article 38 of the Grant Agreement ©

Brief your researchers!

How to contact MSCA fellows?

- National Contact Points: they meet fellows in their meetings (good communicators); supervisors contacts.
- Request supervisors contact details to the EC (data protection)
- All MSCA coordinators will be informed about the NIGHT by the EC
- On-going contact with fellows by the EC to promote the action through the year
- What else?

An effective means of discovering and learning about science

An opportunity for researchers to present/disseminate their results to a wider audience

This interaction is a two way process

The public learns about researchers' research and its relevance

The scientists take away new impetus from the questions of the public
